The Athenian House wine list is dedicated exclusively to wines from Greek vineyards, showcasing both indigenous, century-old grape varieties and international cultivars grown on Greek terroirs by some of the country's most esteemed winemakers. Each selection is carefully curated to complement the restaurant's culinary journey—from Crete & the Cycladic or Ionian Islands, to the Peloponnese & Northern Greece—offering guests an authentic expression of each region. Through these wines, one can discover the unique interplay of climate, soil, and tradition that defines Greece's rich winemaking history and identity.



## Santorini Wines

The vineyards of Santorini are home to some of the rarest and most unique vines in the world, with certain root systems dating back over 400 years. Owing to the island's exceptional terroir, defined by pumice stone & volcanic soils, these ungrafted vines have remained untouched by the phylloxera invasion of the 20th century. This remarkable resilience, combined with the island's harsh climate and ancient viticultural practices, produces wines of striking concentration, vibrant acidity, and pronounced minerality—true expressions of Santorini's singular landscape.

The Athenian House currently owns one of the largest vintage collections of Santorini wines, with rare bottles of assyrtiko, aidani & mavrotragano from the most renowned wineries on the island. Mineral, complex white wines mingle with dry, dense reds from scorched Santorini volcanic earth.



### WHITE WINES

#### ASSYRTIKO

The most famous Santorini white grape variety, gives a very dry, mineral, exceptionally tasty wine, with a saline aftertaste, which embodies the volcanic soil of its birthplace. Assyrtiko has undoubtedly earned the role of Greek ambassador, as the superstar of Greek viticulture worldwide.

#### NYCHTERI

The traditional white 'feast wine' of Santorini, Nychteri is produced primarily from Assyrtiko grapes. Cherished by locals for its dry, structured, oaky character, its name comes from "nychta"—meaning night—referring to the age-old practice of pressing the grapes on the very evening of their harvest. Like most Santorini whites, Nychteri is remarkably versatile and can be enjoyed similarly to a red wine, pairing beautifully with both meat and fish dishes.

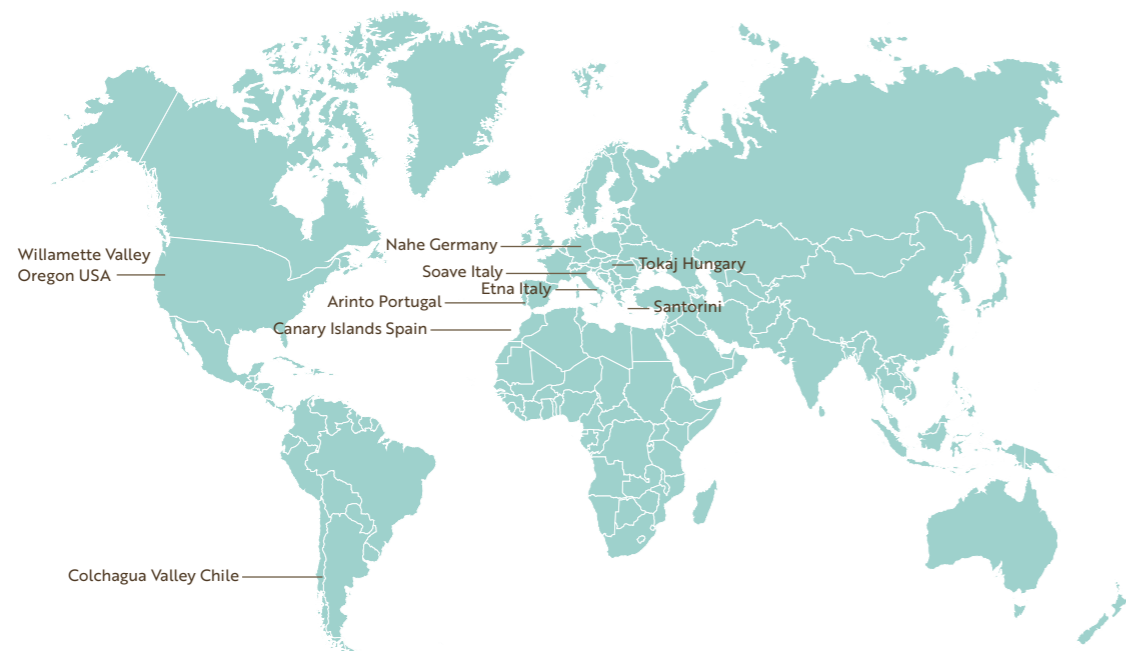

### Our Oenologist Panos Zoumboulis

Born in Athens, Panos Zoumboulis is among the pioneering oenologists of his generation. He began his academic journey in food technology in Athens before continuing his specialization in oenology at the University of Bordeaux, later gaining valuable experience at renowned châteaux across France. Specializing in organic and biodynamic cultivation of vines and olives, his philosophy is deeply rooted in respect for nature and authenticity of terroir. His true passion lies in rare and indigenous grape varieties, particularly those that have remained untouched by the phylloxera catastrophe. A true pioneer with nearly fifty years of expertise, he has built a distinguished career as a consultant oenologist in Greece and Argentina, earning international acclaim for many of his wines.

Panos is a founding member of the “Francs de Pieds” Association ([www.francsdepied.mc](http://www.francsdepied.mc)), based in Monaco, which aims to federate and group together the winegrowers of the Old World, who cultivate ungrafted vineyards, without rootstocks to protect them from phylloxera. The goal is to protect and transmit the age-old know-how of growing indigenous and ungrafted grape varieties on the terroirs where they were born.

Today, Panos and his son Spyros—representing the second generation of the Zoumboulis oenological legacy—have founded Zoumboulis & Associates, a consultancy dedicated to safeguarding the identity of old, ungrafted vines, from Greece and beyond, crafting expressions that remain true to their terroir and to the cultural heritage of each winemaking region.
